- **Volunteer Programs:** Encourage community members to participate in emergency response training and support roles.

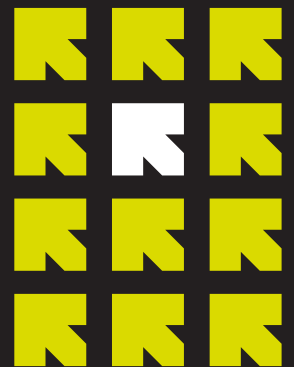
## DEVELOP A LOGISTICS AND SUPPLY CHAIN STRATEGY
